TVTP Program Overview – Project 1



Goal 1: Raise individual awareness of the characteristics of persons mobilizing or radicalizing to violence.



Community Awareness Briefings

- 10 Seminars for 55 high schools
- 8 Train the Trainer seminars for 44 high schools
- Recorded and posted for replay
- \$72,600



TVTP Program Overview – Project 2

Goal 2: Increase youth resilience in through leadership training, greater sense of belonging, and opportunities for civic engagement.



- Reduces violence, bullying, and sexual harassment
- Train 400 faculty and students across 10 different high schools
- Train the Trainer sessions for each of the 14 BA UASI jurisdictions
- Follow up services for sustainment
- \$150,000

TVTP Program Overview – Project 3

Goal 3: Update and implement National Threat Assessment Protocols for 3 High Schools and automate the use of data codified in those protocols.

- Expands San Mateo County program to 3 counties
- Creates mental health, schools, and public safety team
- Updates High School Threat Assessment Protocols and implements data sharing environment
- \$460,000





Goal 4: Enhance the ability of High School Staff and Houses of Faith to recognize the behavioral characteristics of someone about to perpetrate targeted violence

- 10 Seminars for 10 houses of faith
- 8 Train the Trainer seminars for houses of faith
- Recorded and posted for replay
- \$72,166
